I. Program Description

In 2020, Chinese Government Scholarship is expected to support international students who wish to enrol into full-time doctoral degree Programs at Nanjing Agricultural University (hereinafter referred to as NAU) commencing in Academic Year 2020-2021. The successful applicants will be offered the Chinese Government Scholarship (hereinafter referred to as CSC Scholarship) covering the duration of the degree programs.

III. Funding Policy

IV. Application Eligibility

- Applicants must be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China, and be in good health.
- The applicants should hold a Master's degree of relevant field of study and no more than 40 years old when applying for the doctoral programs.

V. Documents Required

(4) Notarized Certificate of Highest Degree/Diploma Achieved	Prospective diploma recipients must submit official document issued by your current school to prove your current student status or expected graduation date. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.
(5) Notarized Academic TRANSCRIPTS of Highest Education Achieved	In Chinese/English Transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.

(6) Constructive Study/ Research Plan	In Chinese/English Must be a minimum of 800 words.
(7) Two Recommendation Letters	In Chinese/English Must be written by professors/associate professors.
(8) Acceptance Letter from a NAU Supervisor	In Chinese/English
(9) Photocopy of Foreigner Physical Examination Form	In Chinese/English Can only be issued and printed by the Chinese Quarantine Authority. Complete the entire examination with proper signature from medical professionals. Limited validity period: six months (A good planning on examination reservations is advised)

(12) Others	Papers published in core academic journals (Only when the applicant is named before the 4th author or the corresponding author, he/she is required to submit) Proof of overseas lab/project/discipline-relevant experience

VI. Application Procedure

Step 1. Find a relevant degree program.

Step 2. Find a relevant supervisor to provide provisional acceptance letter.

Step 3. Prepare application documents. *Please refer to application documents.

Step 4. Send the hard copies of application materials to College of International Education (hereinafter referred to as COIE) before the application deadline. Note: The hard copies of application materials WILL NOT be returned.

Step 5. Pay the non-refundable application fee: **CNY 500 or USD 80**. While transferring application fee to NAU's bank account, please indicate your name and passport number on bank note's remark area for faster identity verification and send the receipt to admission@njau.edu.cn.
